SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

Nowadays active citizenship is one of the greatest challenges of contemporary Europe in a system that is constantly changing and which aims at intelligent, sustainable, and inclusive growth, but students often lack the skills needed to share civic activism as "citizenship practice". Therefore, the project EACiti aims to improve and expand civic education through the exchange of good practices in the teaching/learning of active citizenship considered as a mindset that supports students in a globalized world as socially active, responsible, and cosmopolitan citizens.

The five school exchanges are focused on the following topics:

- fake news and non-hostile communication
- environment protection and sustainable development
- bullying and cyber-bullying
- gender equality
- inclusion and fight against discrimination

The cooperation of students and teachers from different countries is strategic so as to foster the awareness of shared values, seen as a common educational model that allows full awareness of active citizenship.

The good practices shown and observed during the exchanges will be collected in a "toolkit on methods to teach active citizenship and to become an active citizen" addressed to students and teachers.
